Dear Honorable Members of the Energy Commission:

As authorized by the Commission's order of August 24, 2011 (Order No. 11-0824-8), the County of Riverside respectfully submits this comment letter and joins in the arguments made by the California Association of Counties (CSAC) in its brief opposing Applicant's Motion for Order Affirming Application of Jurisdictional Waiver for the Ridgecrest Solar Power Project (Docket No. 09-AFC-9).

The County of Riverside strongly opposes Applicant's request for an order determining that a developer of a photovoltaic electrical generating facility has the discretion to voluntarily submit to the Commission's jurisdiction. The Commission was expressly created by the legislature to site and certify thermal powerplants and related electric transmission lines only. (Public Resources Code section 25500.) Photovoltaic facilities are specifically excluded from the Commission's jurisdiction. (Public Resources Code sections 25110 & 25120.) Jurisdiction over such facilities is instead exclusively vested in local land use authorities by their constitutionally conferred police powers.

If the Commission issues Applicant's requested order, Kern County may, at the election of the Applicant, be deprived of its constitutionally conferred police power to permit the Ridgecrest Solar Power Project. Moreover, as the Commission has recognized, issuance of the requested order would likely have far reaching effects. Other solar power plant developers may seek similar orders and other counties, including Riverside County, may, at the election of those developers, be deprived of their constitutionally conferred police power to permit photovoltaic facilities.
