Dear Honorable Members of the Energy Commission:

The Urban Counties Caucus (UCC), which represents the twelve most populous counties in the state, joins the comments made by the California State Association of Counties (CSAC) in its brief opposing Applicant's Motion for Order Affirming Application of Jurisdictional Waiver for the Ridgecrest Solar Power Project (Docket No. 09-AFC-9).

UCC strongly opposes the request for an order determining that a developer has the ability to ask for the project to be under the Commission's jurisdiction. This would in effect remove the local government's ability to permit the project and would have huge implications on local control for counties. We would also note that photovoltaic facilities are specifically excluded from the Commission's jurisdiction and that this jurisdiction is instead placed in local land use authorities.

Due to the far reaching effects of this order, and the fact that it would impede on a local government's local control over a project, UCC is strongly opposed to this motion and would request that the Energy Commission deny this request.
