BACKGROUND

At the Evidentiary Hearing in Hayward on December 17-18, 2007, the parties did not complete their presentation of evidence on the disputed topics scheduled for hearing. To accommodate the parties and to allow more time for public comment, the Committee has added a third hearing day to complete the receipt of evidence in this matter.

EVIDENTIARY HEARING PROCEDURES

The purpose of the Evidentiary Hearing is to establish the factual record necessary for a decision on the proposed Eastshore Energy Center. The record is developed by the presentation of swom testimony and documentary evidence. **To facilitate receipt of evidence, the parties shall ask their witnesses to identify the exhibits offered in support of their testimony.** At the conclusion of direct testimony, witnesses may be cross-examined, followed by redirect and recross examination as appropriate. Multiple witnesses may testify as a panel, if warranted.

REQUIRED FILINGS

The rules of evidence pertaining to the Evidentiary Hearing are governed by Sections 1212-1213 of the Commission's regulations. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, §§ 1212, 1213; see also § 1702 (h).)

The deadline for filing swom witness testimony and exhibits was December 7, 2007. No additional witnesses or exhibits shall be offered by the parties without a showing of good cause to be determined by the Presiding Committee Member. (See Cal. Code Regs., *supra*, § 1211.) One printed copy of each received exhibit, which has not been previously docketed, shall be submitted to the Energy Commission's Docket Unit by **January 14, 2008**.

Post-hearing briefs shall be filed 10 days after the January 14, 2008, hearing transcript has been posted on the Energy Commission's website. Transcripts of the December 17-18, 2007, hearing will be posted in early January 2008 so that parties will have the opportunity to review those transcripts prior to the January 14, 2008, hearing date.

The Applicant has the burden of presenting substantial evidence to support the findings and conclusions required for certification of the site and related facilities. (Cal. Code Regs., *supra*, § 1748(e).)

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The deadline to file a Petition to Intervene as a formal party in this proceeding was November 19, 2007. No new Petitions to Intervene will be granted.
