Dear Ms. Geffer:

At the close of the Air Quality segment of the December 17, 2007 evidentiary hearing, you directed the applicant and Staff to work with the Bay Area Air Quality Management District ("BAAQMD") to identify reports and other materials that would allay the County of Alameda's ("the County") concerns with the proposed fireplace retrofit air quality mitigation. The next day, the applicant provided several documents from BAAQMD, the California Air Resources Board, and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency that have been marked as Applicant's Exhibit 55.

Having now had the opportunity to review Exhibit 55, the County still has significant concerns that this material did not address. While the materials describe the implementation of the Santa Clara County program and surveys of public interest in the Spare the Air program, they do not evaluate the effectiveness of woodstove replacement as a form of air quality mitigation. The materials also fail to address the County's questions whether the BAAQMD can measure the actual, rather than predictive, impact woodstove replacement has on PM₁₀/PM_{2.5} emissions. These issues are relevant to the County's contention that the woodstove/fireplace retrofitting may not be an appropriate choice of air quality mitigation if its impact cannot be quantifiably ascertained.

The County would appreciate a brief update from the Staff at the January 14, 2008 hearing whether it intends to provide any additional information on this issue in response to the County's concerns. A brief update would provide the public with further information on an issue of significant community concern, and would clarify the parties' positions for purposes of briefing. In the interest of time, the County does not propose another round of cross-examination.

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
