

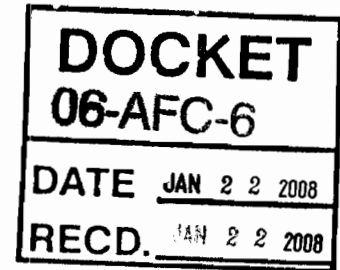



BRIEFING AND SCHEDULING ORDER


At the January 14, 2008, evidentiary hearing in the above-captioned matter, the Committee established a schedule for the submission of legal briefs to assist the Committee in reviewing the record and drafting the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD). The Briefing and AFC Review Schedule, listed below, is hereby adopted by the Committee.

The parties shall file and serve their briefs no later than 5 pm on the due dates listed in the briefing schedule. Given the propensity of some parties to file documents after the established deadlines, all parties shall be on notice that we will not consider any brief filed after the specific deadline for that brief. The parties' briefs shall support any factual assertions with citations to the Exhibits and Reporter's Transcript, including appropriate page and line numbers.

We estimate that the Committee will publish the PMPD by early May 2008. There will be a minimum 30-day public comment period on the PMPD after it is published. The comment period will also include another public hearing in Hayward, to be scheduled subsequent to the PMPD publication date.
