RE: <u>Eastshore (06-AFC-6) - Alameda County's Comments on Draft Distances</u>

Dear Ms. Scholl:

Alameda County ("the County") is in receipt of the Applicant's January 25, 2008 Draft Distances. We appreciate the Applicant's willingness to take the lead in measuring these distances. We are also in receipt of the January 30, 2008 draft from the Energy Commission Staff ("the Staff").

County staff have reviewed both drafts. Although the Staff's draft airport distances do not follow the Alameda County Airport Land Use Commission's ("ALUC") measurement convention, the differences between the distances measured using the Staff's methodology and the ALUC convention are negligible. As a result, the County would be willing to stipulate to the distances contained in the Staff's draft with two modifications.

First, the Hearing Officer's request asked for the distances to the Alameda County Redevelopment Agency's "nearest projects." The County has interpreted that phrase to mean "nearest redevelopment areas." Using that interpretation, the County has provided the enclosed map identifying the distance between the nearest edge of the Eastshore site and the nearest edge of each non-contiguous sub-area of the Mt. Eden Redevelopment Area. The Staff's draft chart should be updated to reflect these five distances.

Second, the Staff's draft asks the Applicant to choose between two measurements for the distance from the RCEC to the Hayward Airport. That distance should be "measured based upon the runway end coordinates provided by R. Baumann, City of Hayward" for a length of 9569 feet. This method of measurement is more consistent with the ALUC convention.
