I realize your are extremely busy, however, I have a question on PPEC in relation to the East Otay Mesa Specific Plan -Table 3.2-1 -Site Planning Standards: Use, Intensity and Bulk Regulations specifies the Max. Building Height in the Heavy Industrial zone is 60 feet. PPEC is proposing 3 -100' stacks -generally would the applicant be required to obtain a variance from the County (along with the Major Use Permit) if the County was processing the application or is it acceptable for the County to sign off of the height when conducting the site plan review per zoning ordinance Section 7150?
