## COMMENTS:

This call was to confirm that organic certification would not be impacted by the air pollutants released from a power plant.

Mr. Green agreed that air pollution from a power plant would not impact adjacent or nearby properties organic certification.

Mr. Green did note that the use of chemicals on the ground near the fence line, such as for weed abatement, could impact organic certification of property directly adjacent to the power plant fence line. In order to avoid that impact either mechanical weed abatement or specific allowable organic chemical means of weed abatement should be used.
