Would this number be considered the number of proposed employees or? Operational employees are proposed at 12
The Site Plan only lists 7 parking spaces plus 1 handicapped space. We will request a Condition of Certification for more spaces but I am wanting to be as accurate as possible in requesting the correct number in order for it to stand up to review.
