## PIO PICO ENERGY CENTER LLC'S PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENT

#### I. INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to the Committee's Notice of Prehearing Conference and Evidentiary

Hearing dated June 15, 2012 (the "June 15th Notice"), Applicant Pio Pico Energy Center

LLC ("Applicant") herein provides its Prehearing Conference Statement in support of Pio

Pico Energy Center Project ("PPEC").

#### II. TOPICS COMPLETE - READY FOR EVIDENTIARY HEARINGS

Applicant believes all resource areas have been adequately analyzed and any potential impacts thoroughly evaluated. In addition, where necessary, mitigation measures have been proposed to minimize any impacts to environmental resources. To that end, Applicant believes all topics are ready for evidentiary hearings.

#### III. TOPICS <u>NOT</u> READY FOR EVIDENTIARY HEARINGS

As set forth in the previous section, Applicant believes all topics are complete and ready to proceed to evidentiary hearings.

#### IV. DISPUTED TOPICS REQUIRING ADJUDICATION

Inasmuch as Applicant believes the topic of Noise and Vibration can be resolved prior to the scheduled July 23, 2012 Evidentiary Hearing, Applicant reserves its option to

present evidence in the issue areas of both Noise and Vibration and Land Use in support of its position regarding this topic. Nevertheless, Applicant summarizes below the nature of the dispute for this topic.

The FSA included language regarding the proposed East Mesa Detention Facility ("EMDF") and set forth noise limits allegedly applicable at the property boundary for that facility. (FSA at 4.6-4.) Staff's proposed Condition of Certification NOISE-4 requires that PPEC noise levels not "exceed 62.5 dBA between 7am and 10pm and 60 dDA between 10pm and 7am measured at EMDF." (FSA at 4.6-14 – 4.6-15.) Applicant disagrees with the proposed limits required at EMDF and the required noise survey at EMDF as such limits are not allow by nor are they consistent with LORS. Further, Applicant contests the inclusion of certain noise limits allowed at LT-1 and LT-2 in NOISE-4 because such limits are based solely on Applicant's initial predicted/expected noise levels and are far more stringent than LORS.

Applicant is diligently trying to communicate with a potential party, Corrections Corporation of America ("CCA"), whom Applicant believes is a source of the position taken regarding the EMDF in the FSA (specifically, in NOISE-4). Applicant is also willing to discuss this topic with Staff counsel in an effort to reach agreement on this issue prior to the evidentiary hearings. Although Applicant will make itself available the morning of July 23, 2012, Applicant believes that a resolution of this topic will occur prior to evidentiary hearings after discussing the topic with Staff and CCA. Therefore, Applicant believes that scheduling a formal workshop (as proposed by Staff in its July 5, 2012 Prehearing Conference Statement) is not necessary.

#### V. APPLICANT'S WITNESSES

# A. Witnesses by Topic Area and Time Required to Present Direct Testimony

Applicant's witnesses for all topics are identified in the table below. However, Applicant believes only one issue (Noise and Vibration) will require live witnesses if the parties are unable to reach agreement on the topic prior to the evidentiary hearing. Thus, on the topic of Noise and Vibration, Applicant will be prepared to present direct testimony and reserves the right to cross-examine witnesses for the parties on this same topic. As such, the time required to present direct testimony for that issue is reflected within the table. All other witnesses will provide testimony by declaration, which was submitted with Applicant's Opening Testimony on June 26, 2012. (See Exhibits 99 through 113.)<sup>1</sup>

Applicant reserves the option of providing witness testimony via telephone by any of the witnesses listed above if it is determined that the parties cannot resolve a particular topic during the Prehearing Conference.

#### VII. CROSS-EXAMINATION LIST

Applicant currently does not wish to cross-examine any witness presented by Staff or Mr. Simpson. Applicant believes all topics can be resolved at the Prehearing Conference and, thus, any presentation of evidence can be presented by the Applicant's representative and legal counsel during the evidentiary hearing on July 23. Nevertheless, as Applicant has not reviewed the parties' respective rebuttal testimony, due July 6, Applicant reserves the right to cross-examine witnesses identified by the parties' should the need arise.

#### VIII. EXHIBITS

#### A. Applicant's Exhibits

Applicant submitted its preliminary list of exhibits with its Opening Testimony on June 26, 2012; such exhibits were enumerated as Exhibit 1 through and including Exhibit 113. A Preliminary Exhibit List also was provided to the parties as Attachment C to Applicant's Opening Testimony. Applicant has since revised its list to include materials docketed since that date (see Exhibits 114 through 129), a copy of which is attached hereto as **Attachment A**. Finally, Applicant has further revised its exhibit list pursuant to the June 15th Notice to include a column identifying to topic to which each exhibit applies. For example, Exhibit 1 (the application for certification, applies to ALL topics). For those topics not necessarily related to an environmental or technical topic, Applicant has identified such exhibit as applying to a "general" category. The categorized Exhibit List is attached herewith as **Attachment B**.<sup>3</sup>

## IX. PROPOSAL FOR BRIEFING DEADLINES AND OTHER SCHEDULING MATTERS

#### A. Post-Evidentiary Hearing Briefing of Remaining Contested Issues

Applicant's representatives and its legal and consultant team is prepared to move forward with the schedule as presented in the June 15th Notice. In addition, Applicant has reviewed the current schedule, contested issues, and parties' testimony and is confident no briefing will be necessary. Nevertheless, should it become clear that legal briefing is warranted beyond the evidentiary hearings, Applicant proposes that any such briefing is closed on or before August 15, 2012. To that end, Applicant offers the following schedule but is amenable to a shorter briefing schedule if the Committee deems necessary:

## **B.** Vacation Schedules and Other Scheduling Matters

Applicant has no conflicts with the current proceeding schedule.<sup>4</sup> Therefore, Applicant urges the Committee to maintain the schedule as presented in the June 15th Notice so that the PPEC AFC can move forward toward receiving a final decision.

#### X. PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION

In its Opening Testimony, Applicant presented proposed modifications to a single Condition of Certification – NOISE-4. Such modifications, presented in Applicant's Exhibit 114 (Attachment A), are discussed in Applicant's Opening and Rebuttal

Testimony, and are presented below for the Committee and Hearing Officer's convenience:

# NOISE-4 The project design and implementation shall include appropriate noise mitigation measures adequate to ensure that the operation of the project will not cause the noise levels due to plant operation alone, during the four quietest consecutive hours of the nighttime, to exceed an average of 3645 dBA Leq measured at or near monitoring location LT-1 and an average of 3439 dBA Leq measured at or near monitoring location LT-2.

Also, the project design and implementation shall include appropriate noise mitigation measures adequate to ensure that the operation of the project will not cause the noise levels due to plant operation alone to exceed 62.5 dBA Leq between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. and 60 dBA Leq between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. measured at EMDF.

The project shall also ensure that it includes any required noise mitigation measures to ensure it does not exceed 80 dBA at the project property line during plant operations.

No new pure-tone components shall be caused by the project. No single piece of equipment shall be allowed to stand out as a source of noise that draws legitimate complaints.

A. When the project first achieves a sustained output of 90% or greater of rated capacity, the project owner shall conduct a community noise survey at monitoring location LT-1 or at a closer location acceptable to the CPM. This survey shall also include measurement of one-third octave band sound pressure levels to ensure that no new pure-tone noise components have been caused by the project.

During the period of this survey, the project owner shall conduct a short-term survey of noise at the monitoring location LT-2 or at a closer location acceptable to the CPM. The short-term noise measurements at this location shall be conducted continuously during the nighttime hours of 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

Also during the period of this survey, the project owner shall conduct a short-term survey of noise at EMDF. The short-term noise measurements at this location shall be conducted continuously during the nighttime hours of 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. and also during the daytime hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

The measurement of power plant noise for the purposes of demonstrating compliance with this condition of certification may alternatively be made at a location, acceptable to the CPM, closer to the plant (e.g., 400 feet from the plant boundary) and this measured level then mathematically extrapolated to determine the plant noise contribution at the affected residence. The character of the plant noise shall be evaluated at the affected receptor locations to determine the presence of pure tones or other dominant sources of plant noise.

Also during the period of the above survey, the project owner shall conduct a short-term survey of noise levels at several points on its property lines, and, if the proposed detention facility has been constructed, an emphasis on the North property line.

- B. If the results from the noise survey indicate that the power plant noise at the affected receptor sites (LT-1 or LT-2) exceeds the above values during the four quietest consecutive hours of the nighttime, mitigation measures shall be implemented to reduce noise to a level of compliance with these limits.
- C. If the results from the **property line** noise survey indicate that the power plant noise at EMDF exceeds the above values 80 dBA during the measurement hours, mitigation measures shall be implemented to reduce noise to a level of compliance with these limits
- D. If the results from the noise survey indicate that pure tones are present, mitigation measures shall be implemented to eliminate the pure tones.

<u>Verification</u>: The survey shall take place within 45 days of the project first achieving a sustained output of 90% or greater of rated capacity. Within 15 days after completing the survey, the project owner shall submit a summary report of the survey to the CPM. Included in the survey report will be a description of any additional mitigation measures necessary to achieve compliance with the above listed noise limit, and a schedule, subject to CPM approval, for implementing these measures. When these measures are in place, the project owner shall repeat the noise survey.

Within 15 days of completion of the new survey, the project owner shall submit to the CPM a summary report of the new noise survey, performed as described above and showing compliance with this condition.

#### XI. CONCLUSION

Applicant looks forward to participating in the evidentiary hearing and is confident these proceedings will provide the final path necessary to lead to a favorable decision by the California Energy Commission for the Pio Pico Energy Center.


