Subject: Response time from station in Shoshone to project site

Project No.:

I called Sheriff Bill Lutze on 11/2/11 but he was in meetings and couldn't talk to me. I called him back on 11/3/11 and was informed by the receptionist that he was out of the office today so I asked if there was someone else who could help answer my questions. I was put through to Lt. Randy Geiger and after explaining that I had already spoken to Sheriff Lutze at the workshop last week and was following up with some specific questions regarding the response times from the Shoshone station to the project site, Lt. Geiger told me that there were many variables to consider due to the project location. He then went ahead and provided me with the following response times:

- 1) If the Sheriff's office received a call and the unit at the Shoshone station (there is only 1 unit at the station) was either at the station or nearby and the incoming call was not a Code 3 (i.e., potentially life-threatening) then the response time from Shoshone to the project site would be 30 minutes. This would be the case whether the incident was in-progress or if it was a cold case. Examples of incidents that are not Code 3 include theft or vandalism.
- 2) If the unit was at the station or around the station and the incoming call was for an in-progress incident that was a Code 3 (i.e., potentially life-threatening), then the response time would be 25 minutes.
- 3) If the Shoshone unit is away from the station and is at the furthest point in the service area from the project site, the response time would be 3 hours. This would be the case despite the fact that the actual distance, as the crow flies, is about an hour away. This is primarily due to the conditions of the roads.
- 4) If the Shoshone unit was occupied elsewhere, then units out of Lone Pine would respond. In this case, the response time would be 3 hours.
