

The Center for Biological Diversity is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to protect imperiled species and their habitats through science, policy and environmental law. For more than a decade, the Center for Biological Diversity has worked to conserve and recover the rare, imperiled, and threatened and endangered species in the California deserts. The Center has advocated for protections for the desert tortoise, Mojave fringe-toed lizard, golden eagle, migratory birds, bighorn sheep, rare endemic desert fish, and many other imperiled species in the California deserts on public and private lands in order to reduce impacts to species and habitats from development, vehicles, predation, and other threats to these fragile desert ecosystems. The Center for Biological Diversity has also participated in the approval process for many site-specific projects and in the planning processes for public and private lands throughout California including in Inyo

The Center is currently an intervenor in one other active proceeding before the

County where the proposed project is found.

Commission for large-scale solar projects in the California desert. The project at issue in this matter will directly impact many desert resources including, but not limited to, the desert tortoise, other imperiled plants and wildlife, and scarce water resources.

The interests of the board, staff, and members of the Center for Biological Diversity are directly affected by the project at issue in this matter. These immediate interests include, but are not limited to, protection of the desert tortoise, conservation of migratory birds and other avian species, conservation of rare and imperiled native plants, conservation of other wildlife species found in the project area, conservation and protection of water resources and water quality, and cumulative impacts to these and other desert resources.

The Center for Biological Diversity wishes to participate fully in all phases of this proceeding. Filings should be served on Lisa Belenky and Ileene Anderson at the addresses listed below. Email service is preferred.

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This petition to intervene is timely and in keeping with the schedule set for this matter which is still at an early stage of the proceedings and no Notice of Prehearing

Conference has yet been issued. The Center's Ileene Anderson participated in the Commission-sponsored site visit for this proposed project on November 3, 2011.

For the foregoing reasons, the Center for Biological Diversity respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition to intervene in this proceeding, and allow the Center for Biological Diversity to participate as a party.
