I review environmental and cultural compliance issues related to nine National Historic Trails that our office administers, or co-administers. One of our trails (co-administered with the Bureau of Land Management) is the Old Spanish National Historic Trail that crosses six western states on its routes from Santa Fe, New Mexico to Los Angeles. The Old Spanish National Historic Trail passes quite near the Hidden Hills Solar Energy Generating Station that is now under development and is being considered by your office. We have great concern about the visual impacts of the very tall power towers proposed for the project on the setting of the Old Spanish National Historic Trail.
