I am a licensed Corporate California Real Estate Broker. The company I represent, KEOL Resources International Corporation currently holds an active authority to exclusively represent the property interest of almost a dozen land owners who currently own hundreds of lots out in the Charleston View area adjacent to the Hidden Hills SEGS.
