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**PROPOSED REVISIONS TO SOIL&WATER-3
TO REFLECT REVISED PHASING PLAN**

SOIL&WATER-3 The proposed Project's use of groundwater during construction shall not exceed ~~204400~~ AFY for Phase I (total of ~~5784,130~~ acre feet during the ~~34~~ months) and 196 AFY for Phase II (total of 552 acre feet). ~~during construction~~ The Project's use of groundwater during operation shall not exceed and ~~204~~ 101 AFY per phase during operation . Water quality used for project construction and operation shall be reported in accordance with Condition of Certification **SOIL&WATER-18** to ensure compliance with this condition.

Verification: Prior to the use of groundwater for construction, the project owner shall install and maintain metering devices as part of the water supply and distribution system to document Project water use and to monitor and record in gallons per day the total volume(s) of water supplied to the Project from this water source. The metering devices shall be operational for the life of the Project.

VERIFICATION: At least 60 days prior to the start of construction of the proposed Project, the project owner shall submit to the CPM a copy of evidence that metering devices have been installed and are operational.

Beginning six months after the start of construction, the project owner shall prepare a semi-annual summary of amount of water used for construction purposes. The

summary shall include the monthly range and monthly average of daily water usage in gallons per day.

The project owner shall prepare an annual summary, which shall include daily usage, monthly range and monthly average of daily water usage in gallons per day, and total water used on a monthly and annual basis in acre-feet. For years subsequent to the initial year of operation, the annual summary shall also include the yearly range and yearly average water use by source. For calculating the total water use, the term "year" shall correspond to the date established for the annual compliance report submittal.
