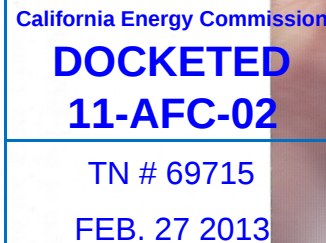

[GOING EASTWARD FROM CALIFORNIA]

Grass good from the Puebla to the Parage Navajos – with the exception of the 1st day from the Cayon.

15 m. from Navajo - to Mesa Spring - no grass, wood or water.
Country bad. Water at Mesa Spring not good - grass good there.
50 m. to Agua De tomaso. few holes with water, but bad.

Road bad to Archilella Spring. large bacons grain grass

If water is not found at the "Parage" about 5 m. N.W. of it we will find it at Le Rocher qui pleu. But it is difficult to water animals. Sometimes water is found at the Lower Escarbado about one league from the Parage.

From this one comes to the Piute Sp. in the 1st little Canion - good water.

12 miles further is the Cayatan Sp. fine water. The vegas of Cayatan 25 miles from the Sp. is another fine Sp. Large. From this a supply of water is necessary. In fact no good water is found until you reach the "Muddy" about 50 m. Sometimes water is found 25 m. from Cayatan. At this point the grass is good. Water in the "Muddy" is warm but good. Must cross at the road, as the "Muddy" is miry & deep. Good camping at the crossing. On this stream is a band of Piutes - bad. On leaving the "Muddy" you cross a desert about 30 m. to the Virgin - bad water. The road here lays up the v. about 45 m. Then you fall on a Spring branch, named Beaver Sp. timber.

On leaving the Beaver Sp. the direction is Northerly for 30 m, and fall on the Santa Clara about 12 m above its junction with the Virgin. 1/2 a mile before you come on the river is a Spring - water fair & very decent grazing.

Follow up this creek 30 m. - bad road & no good camping ground on this Cr except at the cornfields at the head of it. Next comes the Vegas of S. Clara about 30 m. Good place to recruit animals, about 20 m. to the Piute Canon.

From the Vegas of S. Clara you fall on the Quertana Cr. at about 50 m.
