Purpose

The purpose of the workshop is to allow staff, the applicant, intervenors, interested agencies, and the public the opportunity to discuss **Biological Resources** – specifically, applicant's Data Responses to Data Request Set 3, issued on October 26, 2012, related to solar power convective heat and radiant flux and associated potential impacts: http://www.energy.ca.gov/sitingcases/hiddenhills/documents/2012-10-26 Staff Data Request Set 3 199-208 TN-68255.pdf.

These data requests concern what the applicant has termed "the SEDC flux study" which pertains to an experiment conducted in Dimona, Israel. This study was presented at an August 28, 2012, workshop, and considered the effect of solar flux from that facility on dead birds exposed to various levels of solar flux. The workshop is for the sole purpose of discussing that study with the author of the report, who has been identified as Gary Santolo.

No other issues are scheduled for discussion at this workshop, although there will be an opportunity for public comment.

Background

Hidden Hills Solar Electric Generating System

On August 5, 2011, Hidden Hills Solar Holdings, LLC, (subsidiary to BrightSource Energy, Inc.), submitted an Application for Certification (AFC) to construct and operate the Hidden Hills Solar Electric Generating System (HHSEGS). On October 5, 2011, the Energy Commission approved the Executive Director's recommendation that the AFC was deemed complete for purposes of commencing the Energy Commission's siting review process. The Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) was filed on May 24, 2012. The Final Staff Assessment (FSA) was filed on December 21, 2012.

Summary of the Proposed Project

Hidden Hills Solar Electric Generating System

As currently proposed, the HHSEGS would comprise two solar fields and associated facilities permanently encompassing a total of approximately 3,097 acres of privately owned land, leased in Inyo County, California, immediately adjacent to the Nevada stateline. The project site is approximately 8 miles southeast of Pahrump, Nevada, and approximately 45 miles northwest of Las Vegas, Nevada. If approved, each solar plant would generate 250 megawatts (MW), for a total net output of 500 MW and would use heliostats – elevated mirrors guided by a tracking system mounted on pylons – to focus the sun's rays on a receiver steam generator located atop a 750-foot tall solar power tower near the center of each solar field. Each solar plant would utilize approximately 85,000 heliostats. The transmission line and natural gas pipeline would both be located wholly within the state of Nevada on federal land managed by the U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM).

The components of the project located within federal lands noted above, along with the entirety of the project, as a connected action, are being reviewed under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), for which the BLM is the lead agency.

Status of Project Review

As of publication of the Hidden Hills Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) on May 24, 2012, staff has conducted three PSA workshops, on June 14, 2012 (in Pahrump, NV), June 27, 2012 (in Bishop, CA) and July 3, 2012 (in Sacramento, CA). Staff has also participated in two joint Hidden Hills-Rio Mesa workshops focused on avian impact issues, held in Sacramento on August 28, 2012 and December 5, 2012.

The Final Staff Assessment (FSA) published on December 21, 2012 will be staff's testimony, and is only one piece of evidence that will be considered by the Hidden Hills Committee (two Energy Commission Commissioners who have been assigned to the project) in reaching a decision on whether or not to recommend that the full Energy Commission approve the proposed projects.

Staff and other parties anticipated the ability to ask questions about the SEDC flux study prior to publishing the FSA. However, Mr. Santolo was not made available for such questions at the workshop held on December 5, 2012 (although the applicant stated at the workshop that it would make Mr. Santolo available at a subsequent workshop). Staff specifically requests that Mr. Santolo be made available by the applicant at this workshop.

Staff seeks answers to questions about the methods used by Mr. Santolo when he conducted the SEDC flux study for which he provided a report, and intends to testify. Staff had expected these questions to be addressed at the December 5, 2012 Joint Hidden Hills-Rio Mesa Workshop that Mr. Santolo did not attend. At that December 5, 2012 workshop, Staff and other parties were assured by the applicant that Mr. Santolo would be made available at a future workshop to answer such questions, which had tentatively been scheduled to occur on January 31, 2013. However, these questions must still be answered before staff can complete rebuttal testimony for the forthcoming March, 2013 Evidentiary Hearings.
