
Dear Mr. Oglesby:

In accordance with the provisions of Title 20, California Code of Regulations, the two undersigned entities (collectively, the "Applicant") hereby submit this Application for Certification ("AFC") seeking two separate certifications to construct and operate Hidden Hills Solar Electric Generating System plants 1 and 2 and the common area (collectively referred to as "Hidden Hills Solar Electric Generating System" or "HHSEGS"), such that the Conditions of Certification shall apply severally and individually and non-compliance of one plant or entity during the construction or operation phase shall not be deemed non-compliance by the other.

HHSEGS plant 1 is a net 250 megawatt facility to be owned by Hidden Hills Solar I, LLC. HHSEGS plant 2 is a net 250 megawatt facility to be owned by Hidden Hills Solar II, LLC. The Common Area for the two plants will be owned by Hidden Hills Solar I, LLC and Hidden Hills Solar II, LLC, as tenants in common. The two plants and the Common Area are located on private property in Inyo County, California, adjacent to the Nevada border. The HHSEGS site is approximately 18 miles south of Pahrump, Nevada and approximately 45 miles west of Las Vegas, Nevada.

As Chief Executive Officer of BrightSource Energy, Inc., the sole member of Hidden Hills Solar Holdings, LLC, which is the sole member of each of the two Applicant entities aforementioned, I hereby attest, under penalty of perjury, that the contents of this Application are truthful and accurate to the best of my knowledge.
