Dear Mr. Solorio,

The "Quail Brush Power Plant" (11-AFC-03) would violate numerous land use plans/regulations and would be an unacceptable eyesore and health risk to Santee and Tierrasanta. High noise levels would destroy the tranquility of a regional asset -- Mission Trails Regional Park. It must be rejected.

The convenience of the location to natural gas pipelines and high-power electric transmission lines should not overshadow the impact this plant will have on local communities. The fact that the city of San Diego owns this land, far from the city itself, and would consider making a zoning change from residential to industrial is evidence that they would not want it in their own view or backyard and do not care about the welfare of the quiet community of Santee.

I live 2.5 miles from, and in direct view of, the proposed site and chose this location for its tranquility and proximity to Mission Trails Regional Park. The ambience and solitude I now enjoy would be devastated by a power plant being forced upon us in this area.
