I am a resident and homeowner living in an area within a mile of the proposed power plant site. I highly object to this construction plan. Building a power plant will create noise pollution, toxic air pollution, and endanger the wildlife remaining in this area. In addition, this will have a negative effective on my property value. I paid \$330,000 for a home that is now valued at \$160,000. I, unlike many other irresponsible buyers years ago, have personally "eaten" this loss.... I am still paying off this \$330,000 loan and it will be 10-15 years before the property value goes up. Construction would not only be noisy, but will cause yet another nightmare to the traffic problems we have had in this area during the construction of the 125 and 67 freeways.

While all of the above affect me personally... the bigger issue at hand here is the environmental impact that it will have on Mission Trails Regional Park (MTRP). MTRP is one of the last surviving open-space areas where families can bring their children to learn about wildlife. This area that was once the home to the Cuymayaii band of Indians should not be violated. Please, please, please do NOT approve plans for this construction.
