Jeff explained that as most of the property in this section of the East Elliott Community Planning area is privately owned, they would have to either purchase property, or a public access easement from willing property owners, or work with the private owners to exact property or easements when development is proposed. They have discussed with the Quail Brush project applicant the potential of providing a trail within a public access easement across the property's remaining open space, but identified the importance for trail connectivity adjacent parcels. If the trail identified in the Master Plan Update conflicts with the developed portion of the property, the City of San Diego would work with the Quail Brush project applicant to relocate the trail to another part of the property.  Construction of any portion of the trails identified in the Master Plan Update would not coincide with the construction of the Quail Brush project.
