Dear CEC,

After yet another e-mail from the "Stop the Santee Power Plant" urging me to take keyboard in hand and type out a letter to you, I've decided to do so. I didn't like their sample letter at http://stopthesanteepowerplant.files.wordpress.com/2012/03/cec_sample_letter2.pdf so decided to do my own:

I don't envy you your task. Please do your best to provide for the energy needs of California while being respectful to the local regulations and populations which your energy projects may affect. I, for one, neither oppose nor support the Quail Brush proposal.

That being said, it would be nice if the plant were located behind a hill where it isn't visible from Mission Trails Park, but already visible from the park are three power transmission lines, three radio towers, and a sanitary landfill. The park is host to a natural gas main, a sewer line, a freeway segment, and an abandoned mining operation, so it is hardly "pristine". I recognize that the project will not be built on park lands, just adjacent to it. The plant would have plenty of already existing man-made company.
