Per the Committee's Scheduling Order dated March 5, 2012, I (Intervenor Roslind Varghese) hereby submit my Status Report regarding the proposed Quail Brush Generation Project (QBGP).

Since the last report, I have submitted to the docket on 6/14/12 the following:

- Information on the Navy's (navy and marine) efforts in creating renewable energy (Net Zero plans and actions) to reduce their demand on power generated by SDG&E
- The Navy's plans to reduce their demand over the summer to avoid brown outs
- The Navy's letter to the CPUC critiquing the transmission problems artificially generated to prevent them from directing their excess energy to other demand sites and to residential consumers.

Since the military are the largest SDG&E customers in San Diego, these points should be relevant and significant to the overall discussion of the need for this peaker plant and other power plants planned in San Diego. While the Commission staff could say that need is not factored into your evaluation, we believe in practical terms it is, as evidenced by the recent decision on the Encino Plant in Carlsbad.

I plan to soon upload letters of opposition to the Quail Brush power plant from California State Assemblyman Brian Jones, County Supervisor Dianne Jacob, the San Diego River Coalition, among others.

Please note that it would be helpful to the public to have the most up-to-date CEC schedule posted on the website.
