

I am a long time resident of Santee who will be directly effected by the building of this power plant. I live in the Highlands Mobile Home Park which will overlook the planned location of the plant.

My father, now deceased was a retired Air Force Lt. Coronal. His name was Raymond Michael Ziegmont and he and my mother lived in this home for 23 years, I have now lived here for 12 years. He spend several years of his life dedicated to this park and assisted in creating a long term lease on this land. Part of the contract he helped write was to allow the residents right of first refusal if the land came up for sale. It did and about 1 year ago we, as a group, purchased our land giving us the long term security my father hoped for all the residents here. Needless to say, building a power plant which will literally become the view from our windows is an appalling notion. It undoubtably will also have a profound effect of the value of the land we just bought. My father spent 23 years serving his country and many more serving his community and to have this be the outcome is heart sickening to me. I know there is ample open land elsewhere that is not near a school, or a protected wildlife area or huge swath of homes that will be deleteriously effected by pollution, fire hazard and lowering of land values. I know there will also be numerous power lines that will radiate out from the plant further destroying the environment and the esthetic natural beauty of our little valley. Please, do the right thing and find another location for the residents of Santee and in memory of my father, a decorated military hero and man who loved his neighbors and the city of Santee.
