I am a 20yr + resident of Santee, a family centered community. I am not in support of the Quail Brush Generation Project. The project applicant is motivated by financial gain and not what is in the best interest for our children and families under the areas of Fire Protection, Biological resources, Air Quality, Public Health & Cultural resources. The project applicant has also not sufficiently explored the option of a solar energy power generating site. The applicant has had at least one solar site they have developed, owned & operated. The project overall is not in the best interest of the Santee Community and surrounding San Diego area. Mission Trails Regional Park has been thoughtful with their open space planning to include the community's needs and best interest. In addition, the aesthetic appeal of the Quail Brush Generation Project is very lacking.

It would be the new gateway into Santee and a very unwelcome landmark. I would expect that any group who wishes to be added to a community would first consider the (negative) impact of their project on our children and families!!!
