I am a resident of Tierrasanta, and I am writing to urge the CPUC to support Administrative Law Judge Yacknick's 11/20/2012 decision rejecting SDG&E's application 1105023 for the Quail Brush, Pio Pico, and Escondido gas plants.

These fossil fuel plants are unneeded would pose significant health and environmental risks to a heavily populated areas. I have two small children, and the idea of the unnecessary Quail Brush power plant being built so close to their homes and their friends' homes is quite upsetting.

CoGentrix and SDg&E are putting their potential profits above the health of our local communities, by grossly overestimating the need for these plants, and by underestimating the negative impact they will have on the surrounding communities.
