COMMENTS:

I talked to Ms. Perez about lodging availability for relocated construction workers that would be needed to build the Rio Mesa SEGF. She said the busiest time of year is February through August, though they usually have rooms available year-around. The daily rates vary from \$84-\$159. The owner would be willing to negotiate with representatives of a larger group (construction workforce) for a reduced rate over a longer period of time. Ms. Perez believes there would be adequate lodging for Rio Mesa SEGF workers who relocate to the local area during construction.
