#### BACKGROUND DESERT KIT FOX

The desert kit fox is known to occur on the project site and 193 den complexes were observed on site (AFC at 5.2-60). Based on the fact that the desert kit fox actually is a special-status species under Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations and Fish and Game Code Section and should be considered during staff's CEQA review of this project. Because the desert kit fox occupies the proposed project site either as a foraging or breeding mammal, CEC staff must analyze the potential for impacts to this species, especially if natal or satellite dens occur within the site.

In previously permitted projects, the avoidance of impact to the desert kit fox required "passive translocation". However, information on the populations of kit fox (number of burrows, type of burrows, estimate of population) on site was lacking. Based on the mortality of desert kit foxes documented on the Genesis Solar Energy Project, and the subsequent need for the State to capture, monitor, track and inoculate on-site and adjacent off-site kit foxes to prevent further spread of distemper through the desert kit fox populations, we submit the following data request

#### **DATA REQUEST**

 Please provide information on the type of kit fox sign (scat, tracks, and dens) on the proposed site and adjacent off-site areas. Data requested includes a map showing the locations of kit fox sign, kit fox dens and complexes including the number of burrows and whether they are natal or satellite dens and an estimate of the on-site and adjacent population.

#### BACKGROUND: MIGRATORY BIRDS

In 2012-01-12\_Avian\_Survey\_Counterproposal\_for\_CEC\_REAT\_Review\_TN-63365, it is noted that the proposed project is near two Globally Important Bird Areas (GIBAs) – Cibola National Wildlife Refuge and Hall's Island. Additional National Wildlife Refuges – Imperial, Bill Williams and Havasu are identified along the Colorado River in 2012-01-12\_RMSEGF\_CEC

\_Biological\_Workshop\_Presentation\_TN-63357. Other Important Bird Areas (IBAs) also occur in the proposed project area, including Colorado Desert Microphyll Woodlands IBAs and the Lower Colorado River Valley IBAs. Because migratory birds are protected under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, analysis of potential impacts to these species must be evaluated from the proposed project. McCrary et al. (1986) documented significant mortality to avian species from a similar "power tower" technology, primarily from collision with heliostats, but also from singeing from the focused beams.

#### **DATA REQUEST**

- 1. Please provide published and/or peer-reviewed studies on avian mortality from the proposed power tower technology.
- 2. Please provide data on migratory pathways in the general area of the proposed project.
- 3. All original data, modeling and modeling assumptions relied on for statements regarding the SEDC project and Rio Mesa proposed project in the power

point presentation titled "RIO MESA SOLAR ELECTRIC GENERATING FACILITY CEC BIOLOGICAL RESOURCES WORKSHOP March 13, 2012", docketed with the Commission, and posted on the web on March 14, 2012.
