Environmental Resources:

In response to your request for input on the subject project, Environmental Resources has reviewed the document, and offers the following comments:

1. This development should conform to project-level requirements of Section 7, New Development / Significant Redevelopment, of the Orange County Drainage Area Management Plan (DAMP) – http://ocwatersheds.com/Documents/2003_DAMP_Section_7_New_Development_Significant_Redevelopmen.pdf. Implementation of post-construction Best Management Practices consistent with the Model Water Quality Management Plan for Orange County (<http://ocwatersheds.com/DocmgmtInternet/Download.aspx?id=637>) should be required for a priority project such as this, which would include preparation of project Water Quality Management Plan(s).
2. The project would be subject to the General NPDES Permit for Discharges of Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity, Order 2009-0009-DWQ, as may be amended or numbered upon re-issuance.
