Subject: AVENAL ENERGY PROJECT (08-AFC-1) STATUS REPORT 1

Following is Status Report #1 for the proposed Avenal Energy project.

Current Issues and Activities for Resolution

Staff has encountered the following issues during the discovery and analysis phases of the Application for Certification (AFC) for the proposed Avenal Energy project:

- On June 10, 2008 Avenal Power Center LLC (applicant), filed objections to data requests #16 (modifications made to the Gates Substation), #53 (use of neighboring agricultural wells as a back-up water supply), and #66, 67, and 68 (environmental assessment of demolition and disposal of farm office and storage area). On June 20, 2008 the applicant provided responses to the remaining data requests. After reviewing information exchanged at the July 1, 2008 Data Response and Issues Resolution Workshop and supplemental information provided by the applicant, staff has determined that the following data requests require further action:
 - Data Requests #5 and #6 (Air Quality): Staff will consult with the local air quality district regarding emission rates during excursions and rapid load changes.
 - Data Request #7 (Biological Resources): Staff will continue discussions with the California Department of Fish and Game and the United States Fish and Wildlife Service regarding the placement of setbacks and fences.
 - Data Request #10 (Biological Resources): Other than burrowing owls, the applicant did not provide a description of impact avoidance measures for potentially impacted species, however, applicant understands that staff's recommended mitigation measures will include avoidance measures for other listed species.
 - Data Request #25 (Soils and Water Resources): At the July 1, 2008 workshop the applicant agreed to provide a 100 year flood boundary grading plan.
 - Data Request #53 (Soils and Water Resources): Staff will contact Westlands Water District to confirm whether the wells are available for use by the applicant (see Agency Comments below for additional information).

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- Data Request #56, #57, and #58 (Transmissions System Engineering): Staff will
 review the system impact study when it becomes available. This is a critical piece of
 information which staff will need to determine the project's potential impact on
 downstream transmission facilities and the related environmental impacts if any
 downstream facilities require upgrading. Staff will need this document to complete
 the Final Staff Assessment.
- o Data Requests #66, #67, and #68 (Waste Management): The applicant has advised staff that the structures referred to in these data requests will not be demolished. However, the Applicant has not provided any assessment of the soils that might be disturbed during construction of the transmission and natural gas lines. Staff will need such information in order to complete its analysis of potential project impacts and such information has been provided in previous projects. Therefore, is currently considering how best to obtain this information.

Agency Comments

- Westlands Water District submitted comments, dated May 29, 2008, regarding the use of well and groundwater for non-agricultural purposes and the need for the applicant to obtain Westland's approval before identifying well water as a back-up water supply. At the July 1 Data Response and Issues Resolution Workshop the applicant indicated that Westlands has not responded to its request for documentation supporting its contention that Westlands has ownership of the wells and that its Board of Directors must approve any use of the water for the power plant. Staff will contact Westlands to request documentation confirming the ownership of the well(s).
- The California Department of Fish and Game submitted comments, dated May 27, 2008, regarding potential mitigation measures for the loss of Swainson's hawk and San Joaquin kit fox habitat, and issues related to the disturbance of burrowing owls and tri-colored blackbirds.

The California Department of Conservation submitted written comments, dated April 4, 2008, requesting an analysis of the proposed impact of Avenal Energy on agricultural land, including lands under Williamson Act contract..

Schedule
