Purpose

The Energy Commission is currently reviewing Avenal Power Center, LLC's (Avenal Power) Application for Certification for the proposed development of Avenal Energy. To facilitate its review of the Application for Certification, the Energy Commission published data requests on May 22, 2008 for the following technical areas: air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, hazardous materials management, land use, soil and water resources, transmission system engineering, waste management, and worker safety/fire protection.

The July 1, 2008 Data Response and Issue Resolution Workshop will focus on Avenal Power's June 10, 2008 data responses, additional data responses to be provided by June 20, 2008 and the resolution of related issues and concerns. Following the workshop, staff will consider the responses and comments it receives, if necessary submit a second round of data requests, and publish a Preliminary Staff Assessment containing a preliminary analysis of issues and recommendations for mitigation and conditions of certification.

Background

On February 21, 2008, Avenal Power filed an Application for Certification with the Energy Commission for the Avenal Energy generating facility. Avenal Power is seeking Energy Commission approval to construct and operate a 600-megawatt (MW) generating facility in the city of Avenal in Kings County under the Commission's standard 12-month power plant licensing process. The proposed generating facility would use dry cooled, combined cycle technology, consisting of two natural gas-fired General Electric 7FA gas turbines with heat recovery steam generators (HRSG) and one General Electric steam turbine. If approved, the generating facility would be built on 25 acres of a 148-acre industrial zoned site located within the Avenal city limits, just south of the Fresno County line and approximately two miles east of Interstate 5.
