APPLICANT'S STATUS REPORT NO. 6

In accordance with the Committee Scheduling Order dated May 7, 2009, San Joaquin Solar 1 LLC and San Joaquin Solar 2 LLC, collectively referred to as San Joaquin Solar or "Applicant", submits its sixth status report in this proceeding.

STATUS OF THE PROCEEDING

This Application was deemed Data Adequate in March 2009. Over the past year, the Applicant and Staff have worked vigorously and cooperatively in developing the necessary information to process this Application.

The Applicant filed its fifth Status Report on October 12, 2009. There have been a number of significant developments since our last report.

CAISO

As we reported in our letter of January 6, 2010 to Melissa Jones, the Project did not post with the CAISO the security deposit for the transition cluster Phase II study that was due in December 2009.

However, we are very pleased to report that on January 31, 2010, the Project has submitted a new interconnection request with the CAISO and the Project has posted the required

initial deposit of \$250,000. Therefore, the Project will be once again moving forward in the interconnection study process within the current cluster window.

DATA SUBMISSIONS

San Joaquin Solar has worked very hard over the past three months to satisfy all outstanding data requests. Since our last status report, we have filed the requested results of the 2009 biological surveys, certain Phase II sampling results, a Report of Waste Discharge, and data responses to CURE data requests as directed by the Committee's order of December 16, 2009.

PRELIMINARY STAFF ASSESSMENT

Staff's sixth Status Report, issued November 9, 2009, had targeted issuance of the Preliminary Staff Assessment ("PSA") for December 15, 2009. It is our understanding that the Staff has all of the information it needs to complete the PSA. We are not aware of any issue that would prevent the issuance of the PSA at this time.

REQUEST FOR TIMELY PROCESSING OF THIS APPLICATION

The filing of the new transmission interconnection request with the CAISO by the Project is a very strong indication that San Joaquin Solar remains firmly committed to the timely completion of this proceeding and to construction of the proposed project. The San Joaquin Solar project will make a substantial contribution to meeting the State's renewable energy goals through the innovative application of solar and biomass technologies. It is vital that the Commission continue the timely review of this Application so that a Final Decision can be made in 2010 and so that the Project will remain eligible for Federal stimulus funds.

The Staff has all of the information it needs to finalize the Preliminary Staff Assessment. The Applicant stands ready to assist the Staff and Committee in the timely completion of this proceeding.
