Dear Mr. Meyer and Mr. Stobaugh:

The Applicant respectfully requests additional time, beyond the 30-day period from when the CEC and BLM Staff Data Requests Set 1, Part 2 (Requests 92-127) were docketed, to respond to some of the requests. Most responses to CEC and BLM Data Requests, with the exception of Cultural Resources and Public Health and Safety, will be docketed within the 30-day period. However, we request an extension until August 31, 2009 to respond to the Public Health and Safety Data Requests (109-112) because the responses are dependent upon the revised Air Quality modeling. Therefore, the Applicant will docket the Public Health and Safety Responses with the Air Quality responses (Data Requests 1-49) on or before August 31, 2009.

The Applicant also respectfully requests additional time to respond to the Cultural Resources Data Requests (Data Requests 92-108). Due to both the content and extent of the responses, it is anticipated that the Applicant will provide responses during the late third or early fourth quarter of 2009. It should be noted that during ongoing consultation with the CEC and BLM, this date may change and that, if or when it does, the Applicant will notify the CEC and BLM of such changes. That said, the Applicant is making and will continue to make every possible effort to respond to all CEC and BLM Staff Data Requests as soon as possible.
