Thank you for extending our comment due date since our office did not receive the document in a timely manner. We also appreciated the previous interaction we have had with project representatives regarding access issues in December 2007.

We have the following comments:

- The description of improvements to SR-14 at the existing at-grade median crossover (section 2.5.6.5 and 5.13) are per previous discussions with project representatives. Design and Traffic Management Plan details will be further defined during the encroachment permit phase.
- If the project security fence is to also function as the right-of-way fence, it shall meet Caltrans standards.
- The transmission line crossing at SR-14 shall be at a 90-degree angle.
