To whom it may concern:

We recommend Beacon a subsidiary of Nextara pay for the testing of the ground water levels, chemical components, (arsenic, alkali, copper ect.) and the total coliform and E. coli, each month or as demanded by law and any other Health Department requirements. Including standards for State and Federal water regulations and rules. This recommendation would be in affect for the duration of the project plus 20 years there after. Recommend that all water testing be done at an independent laboratory at Rancho Seco's discretion.

If at anytime during Beacons project or 20 years there after the potable water becomes **contaminated** Beacon will provide Rancho Seco and Cantil community potable water for our homes and businesses.

All reports to be sent to Rancho Seco Incorporated and the Health Department as soon a possible according to the requirements and laws of the Health Department and for notification of members of any and all hazards to the potable water.

The ground water levels shall be tested at two-week intervals during construction. After construction ground water levels shall be tested for at least two years at 2-month intervals than every year there after.

The <u>reason</u> for this recommendation is that Beacon will be using recycled water and other hazardous chemicals that may affect our drinking water.
