DOCUMENT HANDLING FOR THE REVISED STAFF ASSESSMENT FOR THE PROPOSED MARSH LANDING GENERATING STATION (08-AFC-3) and POSTING OF PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF THE REVISED STAFF ASSESSMENT FOR THE MARSH LANDING GENERATING STATION, APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION (08-AFC-3)

This notice is to inform you that the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) staff has prepared a Revised Staff Assessment (RSA) for the Marsh Landing Generating Station (MLGS) Application for Certification (AFC). Additionally, this notice is to inform you of the availability of the RSA, which was published by the Energy Commission staff on June 10, 2010. The RSA contains the staff's engineering, public health, and environmental evaluation of the proposed Marsh Landing Generating Station.

Staff previously published a Staff Assessment for the MLGS project on April 26, 2010 for a 30 day comment and review period. This Revised Staff Assessment (RSA) has been prepared based upon discussions at the Staff Assessment workshops and written comments provided by the applicant, agencies and public.

The Energy Commission encourages public and agency participation in the review of staff's RSA. The RSA is available for public review at the following site:

The RSA contains responses to written comments provided on the MLGS Staff Assessment (SA), which was published by staff on April 26, 2010. A 30-day comment period for the SA concluded on May 26, 2010. The MLGS project is scheduled for evidentiary hearings before the Energy Commission committee on July 1, 2010. The RSA will serve as Energy Commission staff's testimony during evidentiary hearings held by the Energy Commission. The Energy Commission Committee assigned to the MLGS proceedings will consider and weigh the testimony and or comments and or recommendations of all interested parties, including Energy Commission staff, the applicant, intervenors, public, and other local, state, and federal agencies, before issuing the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD) for consideration by the full Energy Commission. The public, intervenors, local, state and federal agencies are encouraged to participate in these hearings. The Energy Commission will issue notices at least ten days prior to any scheduled hearings.

SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSED MARSH LANDING GENERATING STATION

The RSA contains the Energy Commission staff's evaluation of the MLGS. The proposed 760-megawatt (MW) MLGS electric generating plant and related facilities are under the Energy Commission's licensing jurisdiction and cannot be constructed or operated without the Energy Commission's certification. The RSA contains analyses similar to those normally contained in an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). When issuing a license, the Energy Commission is the lead state agency under CEQA, and its process is functionally equivalent to the preparation of an EIR.

The Energy Commission staff has the responsibility to complete an independent assessment of the project's engineering design and its potential effects on the environment, the public's health and safety, and whether the project conforms to all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations and standards (LORS). The staff also recommends measures to mitigate potential significant adverse environmental effects and conditions of certification for construction, operation and eventual closure of the project, if approved by the Energy Commission.

This RSA is not the decision document for these proceedings, nor does it contain findings of the Energy Commission related to environmental impacts or the project's compliance with local/state/federal legal requirements. The RSA serves as staff's official, sworn testimony in evidentiary hearings to be held by the Committee assigned to this proceeding, comprised of two Commissioners and a Hearing Officer. After evidentiary hearings, the Committee will consider testimony and comments presented by staff, the applicant, other parties to the proceeding, governmental agencies and the public – all aspects that comprise the official record of this proceeding -- and issue a Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD). Following a public hearing, the full five-member Energy Commission will make its final decision on this power plant application based upon the PMPD, comments by parties to the proceeding and input from members of the public.
