

Purpose of Siting Process

" to ensure that a reliable supply of electrical energy is maintained at a level consistent with the need for such energy, for protection of public health and safety, for promotion of the general welfare, and for environmental quality protection."

Public Resources Code 25001



Energy Commission's Role

Energy Commission permitting authority

- Thermal power plants ≥ 50 megawatts
- Related facilities
 - electric transmission lines
 - water supply pipelines
 - natural gas pipelines
 - waste disposal facilities
 - access roads
- Lead state agency for California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

Overview of Three-Step Licensing Process: <u>Step 1</u> - Data Adequacy <u>Step 2</u> - Staff Discovery & Analysis


1. Data Adequacy - Minimum requirements to accept application

2. Staff Discovery & Analysis

- Issues Identification
- Data requests
- Workshops
- Final Staff Assessment
 - Determine if proposal complies with Laws, Ordinances, Regulations & Standards (LORS)
 - Conduct engineering and environmental analysis
 - Identify issues
 - Evaluate alternatives
 - Identify mitigation measures
 - Recommend conditions of certification
- Make recommendations to the Committee



Staff Discovery & Analysis Process




Overview of Three-Step Licensing Process: <u>Step 3</u> – Evidentiary Hearing and Decision

3. Evidentiary Hearing and Decision

- Committee conducts Evidentiary Hearing
- Committee produces Presiding Member's
 Proposed Decision (PMPD) containing findings relating to:
 - environmental impacts, public health, engineering
 - compliance with LORS
 - recommending Conditions of Certification
 - recommending whether or not to approve the project
- PMPD goes before full Commission for decision
- If approved, Energy Commission monitors compliance with all Conditions of Certification for the life of the project, including facility closure

Staff's Issues Identification Report

Purpose

- Inform participants of potential issues
- Early focus on important topics
- Criteria
 - Significant impacts that may be difficult to mitigate
 - Non-compliance with LORS
 - Conflicts between parties about appropriate findings or conditions of certification for Commission decision



Potential Issues Identified by Staff

- USFWS, USCOE, and DFG have not completed their review of the project and approved proposed mitigation/avoidance measures.
- LAFCO process to annex project to the North County Fire Protection District is pending.
- Potential impacts related to water truck delivery to the project have not been analyzed and determined.



Project Schedule

The schedule considers/assumes the following:

- High siting workload is generally causing an overall delay to all projects
- Applicant is able to provide a timely response to staff's data requests
- Determinations of other local, state, and federal agencies will be on-schedule
