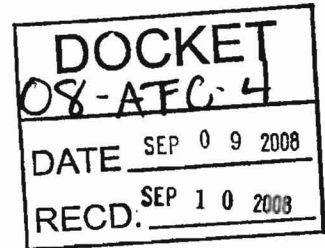

Amanda: It's very unlikely that I can change my calendar to make a meeting in Fallbrook on Thursday; however, I'll see what I can do....or if someone else at LAFCO can attend.

A common practice is to condition development permits on jurisdictional boundary changes to secure public services. It's a circular process; however, LAFCO requires the Environmental determination that the lead agency will render before the LAFCO process can begin...and it is generally the path followed.



On October 6, LAFCO will consider a proposal to authorize the County to provide structural fire protection and EMS in certain unincorporated areas.....including the Orange Grove project territory. It is likely that LAFCO approval will be conditioned upon the County securing contracts for services with surrounding agencies (NCFPD would be of interest to the Orange Grove project). Regrettably, the final answer about fire protection would not be resolved until the County finalized contracts for service. Or, if contracts are not forthcoming, there may be actions proposed to annex territory into surrounding agencies.
