
At the final day of hearings held in El Centro on May 24, 2010 on this matter, the parties and the Committee discussed the filing of briefs on certain topics. Today, Applicant Imperial Valley Solar, LLC (IVS) is filing two legal briefs. One concerns the information required by this Committee and the Commission in the area of water supplies for the Project. The second brief concerns whether a final US Army Corps of Engineers Least Environmentally Damaging Project Alternative (“LEDPA”) is required prior to Staff’s issuance of its SSA and the Commission’s consideration of the IVS Project.

Any party to this proceeding may file a motion regarding this application (20 CCR § 1716.5) and the Presiding Member has been given great latitude over the conduct of these proceedings (see 20 CCR § 1203 (a)). This motion requests this Committee to direct parties to file their responses, if any, to the two Applicant briefs before the close of business on Friday, June 18, 2010. This will allow the Applicant, the Committee and other parties the opportunity to consider these responses prior to the June 21, 2010 Mandatory Status Conference. This motion also requests that this Committee instruct all parties to the proceeding to present any rebuttal testimony on the Staff’s conclusions or the Applicant’s direct testimony regarding Project water supplies or minimization of impacts on ephemeral waters no later than July 5, in preparation for final hearings contemplated for mid-July.

Applicant IVS hereby moves the Committee in this proceeding to require any responses to the two June 14, 2010 briefs be filed by close of business on Friday, June 18, 2010, and any rebuttal testimony to be filed by close of business on Monday, July 5, 2010.
