Purpose of Prehearing Conference

The Prehearing Conference is a public forum where the Committee will assess the parties' readiness for an evidentiary hearing, identify areas of agreement or dispute, and discuss the remaining schedule and procedures necessary to conclude the certification process. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1718.5.)

At the Prehearing Conference, all parties (Staff, Applicant, and Intervenor) shall present their respective positions regarding: the substantive topic areas ready for evidentiary hearing; those that require further analysis, including the nature of, and time frame for, any such analysis; the topic areas that have been resolved; and the topic areas that are disputed and require adjudication. The parties shall also identify proposed witnesses, as well as the time required for direct testimony and/or cross-examination.

Local, state, and federal governmental agencies may participate at the Prehearing Conference and Evidentiary Hearing, as necessary. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1714.5.) Elected officials and members of the public may present public comments at these events and/or submit written comments to the Energy Commission's Docket Unit. Please include "Docket No. 08-AFC-7" on any written comments.

Prehearing Conference Statements

To facilitate the process, each party shall serve and file a **Prehearing Conference Statement**. The statements shall be received by the other parties and the Commission's Docket Unit, 1516 9th Street, MS-4, Sacramento, California 95814-5512, by **3 p.m. on November 12, 2009**. The parties shall e-mail their statements to the Hearing Officer as well as to the Docket Unit and the parties as indicated on the Proof-of-Service list. The parties shall also submit a WORD version of their statements to the Hearing Officer via email. *FAILURE TO FILE A TIMELY PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENT MAY PRECLUDE A PARTY FROM PARTICIPATING AT THIS HEARING*.

Each statement shall specify:

- 1. The topic areas that are complete and ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing;
- 2. The topic areas that are not complete and not yet ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing, and the reasons therefor;
- 3. The topic areas that remain disputed and require adjudication, and the precise nature of the dispute for each topic;
- 4. The identity of each lay and expert witness sponsored by each party (note: expert witnesses must have professional expertise in the scope of their testimony); the topic area(s) which each witness will present; a brief summary of the testimony to be offered by each witness; qualifications of each witness; and the time required to present direct testimony by each witness;
- 5. Topic areas upon which a party desires to cross-examine witnesses, a summary of the scope of such cross-examination, and the time desired for such cross-examination:
- A list identifying exhibits and declarations that each party intends to offer into evidence and the technical topics to which they apply (see following section on format);
- 7. Proposals for briefing deadlines and other scheduling matters;
- 8. For all topics, the parties shall review the proposed Conditions of Certification listed in the Final Staff Assessment (FSA) for enforceability, comprehension, and consistency with the evidence, and submit any proposed modifications.

Formats for Presenting Evidence

The parties shall provide exhibits containing all written testimonial and documentary evidence in two formats.

- 1. Each exhibit shall be numbered and identified on an **Exhibit List**:
 - Applicant's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as Exhibits 1 through 199;
 - Staff's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as Exhibits 200 through 299;
 - Intervenor CURE's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as Exhibits 300 through 399; and
 - Intervenor Sarvey's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as Exhibits 400 through 499.

Printed copies of each party's exhibits, including intervenors' exhibits, organized as described above under Format "1," shall be submitted to all

other parties, including intervenors, the Hearing Officer, and the Committee, at or before the Prehearing Conference and supplemented at the Evidentiary Hearing, as necessary.

2. To facilitate the Committee in preparing the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision, printed copies of the exhibits for each topic area shall *also* be compiled in separate file folders, or in a binder with numbered separators, designated by topic with the appropriate Exhibit Number attached to each document within each topic. Exhibits organized in this fashion need be provided only to the Committee and the Hearing Officer.

Petitions to Intervene to Become a Formal Party

The Energy Commission's Decision on the GWF Tracy Combined Cycle Power Plant Project will be based on the official evidentiary record developed at the Evidentiary Hearing. Only formal parties (Applicant, Staff, and Intervenors) may present evidence and cross-examine witnesses at the Evidentiary Hearing.

Anyone with an appropriate interest in the Project may file a Petition to Intervene and become a formal party. At the Evidentiary Hearing, a formal party may offer testimony and documentary evidence, receive documents filed by other parties, and cross-examine witnesses. An Intervenor must also comply with Committee orders, procedures, and filing requirements, and is subject to discovery and having its own witnesses cross-examined by other parties.

The deadline to file a Petition to Intervene in this case is **Tuesday, November 17, 2009.** (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1207.) Time extensions will not be granted for new Intervenors to review case materials.

How to Intervene

From the Central Valley (Sacramento, Elk Grove, Lodi, Manteca, Lathrop):


Take Interstate 5 south to the Tracy exit (458A).
