To the Project Manager:

On August 25, 2008, the City of Palmdale filed an application for confidentiality on behalf of the Palmdale Hybrid Power Project (Docket No.08-AFC-9). The application seeks confidentiality for the Paleontological Resources Technical Report prepared by SWCA on your behalf.

The application does not contain a legible signature of the person making the certification under penalty of perjury, as required by California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(a)(1)(G). Staff Counsel Deborah Dyer informs me that she made several requests that a legible signature page be submitted in support of the application, but that she never received the requested information. Since it is not clear who is making the attestation, the application is deficient, and is hereby denied pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(a)(3)(A).

In light of the subject matter of the application, I suggest that you submit another complete application. The information contained in the original application will not be available for public inspection or copying for a period of fourteen days from the date of this letter. The procedures and criteria for filing, reviewing, and acting upon such petitions are set forth in the California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2504, *et. seq.* If you have any questions concerning this matter, please contact Deborah Dyer, Senior Staff Counsel, at (916) 654-3870.
