COMMENTS:

Here is a summary of my conversation with Dan:

- The Waterworks will be entering into a contract with the Palmdale Hybrid project for tertiary water. This contract is expected to be signed in mid-July.
- The contract will be to supply reclaimed water for the Palmdale Hybrid project and for the project owner to construct a pumphouse and pipeline for delivery of the reclaimed water.
- The contract does not include a backup water supply. Apparently the City did not want to pay the \$10 million required costs to build a pipeline to the Lancaster Water Reclamation Plant (LWRP) for this backup supply. But the AFC specifically states the backup supply would come from the LWRP via the regional reclaimed water pipeline.
- Dan does not know where the Palmdale Hybrid project will get its backup water supply.
