Subject: Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement for the Palmdale Hybrid

**Power Plant** 

Dear Ms. Miller.

The Department of Fish and Game (Department) has reviewed the Lake or Streambed Alteration Notification ("Notification"), submitted on July 10, 2009 by the City of Palmdale for the Palmdale Hybrid Power Plant Project (Project). The Notification and filing fee were submitted to the Department in anticipation of the applicant meeting the Department's requirements pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602 et. seq. However, any impacts to streams in association with the Project will ultimately be permitted by the California Energy Commission (CEC), pursuant to the Warren-Alquist Act. Although CEC will serve as the permitting agency, the substantive criteria for a Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement must still be met. The Department provides the following comments to the CEC regarding the applicant's Notification.

The Department requested the Notification because the proposed gas, water, and Transmission line routes cross or run adjacent to Department jurisdictional streams. Based on the information provided in the Application for Certification, the Department determined there was a potential the project could "substantially divert or obstruct the natural flow of, or substantially change or use any material from the bed, channel, or bank of, any river, stream, or lake, or deposit or dispose of debris, waste, or other material containing crumbled, flaked, or ground pavement where it may pass into any river, stream, or lake." Once the Notification was received, the Department determined the application was incomplete pending a July 29, 2009 site visit.

On July 29, 2009, the City provided a video and map presentation of the proposed stream crossings, and a site visit was conducted along the Transmission route where several jurisdictional streams would be crossed using existing Arizona crossings. The Department requested a table containing the locations of all stream crossings with a description of the construction methods and the avoidances and minimization measures being implemented to avoid and minimize impacts to jurisdictional streams. The Department received the requested information on August 18, 2009. Once these items were received the Department deemed the application complete.

Based on the subsequent information provided, the Department has determined that the project is <u>subject</u> to the <u>notification requirement</u> in Fish and Game Code section 1602, including the fee. However, the Department has determined that because of the comprehensive avoidance and minimization measures the City has incorporated into the project, the project would <u>not result in a substantial adverse impact to existing fish or wildlife resources</u>. The Department will assist the CEC in determining the scope and nature of conditions for certification and will be providing CEC with recommendations to this effect.
