Pursuant to Title 20, California Code of Regulations, Section 1716.5, Applicant files this petition requesting minor modifications to the schedule issued by the Committee on November 6, 2010.

On November 6, 2010, the Committee issued a Committee Scheduling Order in this matter. The Applicant appreciates the establishment of firm dates for completion of these proceedings. According to the schedule issued by the Committee, Staff is to file a complete Final Staff Assessment (FSA) by December 20, 2010. While Staff is providing FSA sections to the Applicant as they become available, which Applicant appreciates, it appears that the most critical sections of the FSA will not be available until close to, or on, the December 20, 2010 deadline. The current schedule requires Applicant to file its testimony by January 5, 2011. Thus, the period for Applicant to review the FSA, and prepare and file its testimony, coincides with the Christmas and New Year holidays and associated vacations.

In order to provide Applicant adequate time to review the complete FSA, and prepare and file its testimony, Applicant is requesting minor modifications to the schedule, to allow one additional week for Applicant to complete its analysis and testimony. The proposed changes in the schedule only slightly shorten the period between the filing of rebuttal testimony and prehearing conference statements (from 7 days to 3 days), and the period between filing of prehearing conference statements and the prehearing conference (from 8 days to 6 days). The proposed changes do not affect any scheduled hearing dates. Applicant has discussed these proposed changes with CEC Staff, and Staff has indicated that it is not opposed to the changes.

In addition, Staff has indicated a desire to modify the deadlines for the filing of opening briefs from February 9, 2011 to February 16, 2011, and reply briefs from February 16, 2011 to February 23, 2011. Applicant does not object to these modifications to the schedule.

In summary, the modifications proposed by Applicant and Staff are as follows:
