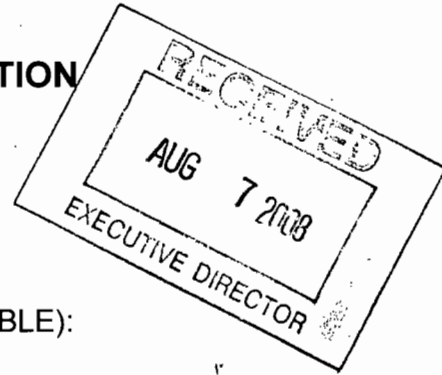

The documents referred to in 1(a) above in their entirety.

2. State and justify the length of time the Energy Commission should keep the information or data confidential.

Documents referenced in 1(a) above should be kept confidential in perpetuity or until returned to the Applicant.

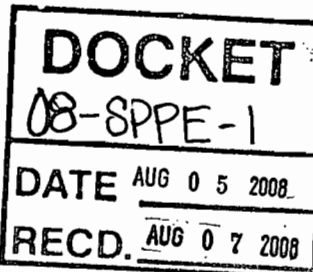

Records prepared by or for the City of Riverside that assess its vulnerability to terrorist attack or other criminal acts intended to disrupt the City of Riverside's operations and that is for distribution or consideration in a closed session. [Government Code section 6254(aa)].

Records containing critical infrastructure information, as defined in Section 131(3) of Title 6 of the United States Code, that are voluntarily submitted to the California Office of Homeland Security for use by that office, including the identity of the person who or entity that voluntarily submitted the information. [Government Code section 6254(bb)].

Records may be withheld where the public agency can justify withholding by demonstrating that the public interest served by not disclosing the record clearly outweighs the public interest served by disclosure.

Here, the protection of sensitive energy infrastructure security information is vital to providing secure, reliable energy, which outweighs any public interest served by disclosure. [Government Code section 6255].



- 3(b). Discuss the public interest in nondisclosure of the material submitted for a confidential designation. If the material contains trade secrets or its disclosure would otherwise cause loss of a competitive advantage, please state how it would be lost, the value of the information to the applicant and the ease or difficulty with which the information could be legitimately acquired or duplicated by others.

The documents referenced in 1(a) above should be kept confidential to protect the security of the RERC Facility.
