SPPE Appropriate. The Assigned Committee requested that Staff file "an issues identification report summarizing any potential issues including, but not limited to, whether or not staff believes the proposed addition of 95 MW of generating capacity to the existing 96 MW within 3 ½ years of the Commission Decision exempting Units 1 & 2 is also eligible for exemption or, alternatively, is a single 191 MW project built in two stages".

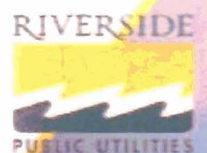
Applicant anticipates that Staff will agree that the addition of Units 3 and 4 at RERC is being addressed appropriately through the SPPE process. In the event the Committee has concerns over the appropriateness of an SPPE, Riverside Public Utilities would like to present testimony supporting its position that an SPPE is appropriate for this application.
