

MORRO BAY MODERNIZATION AND REPLACEMENT POWER PLANT PROJECT (00-AFC-12) – AUTHORIZATION TO START TANK FARM DEMOLITION ACTIVITIES

Dear Ms. Irwin:

Energy Commission staff has completed its review of the pre-demolition conditions of certification submittals for the Morro Bay Tank Farm demolition and has determined that all demolition activities for this portion of the Morro Bay Modernization and Replacement Power Plant project may commence, per your schedule, as of May 23, 2010.

The Energy Commission will continue to work closely with Dynegy to ensure conformance with all conditions of certification per the Energy Commission's Amended Order dated June 22, 2005. Lack of conformance with any of the conditions of certification may result in suspension of demolition activities.

Energy Commission staff will be visiting the site during demolition activities to ensure compliance with conditions of certification applicable to the tank farm demolition. Also, please submit notification when the demolition is complete with a short summary and discussion about any issues encountered during the activities.
