Enclosed please find a copy of the Energy Commission Order approving the extension of operation for Units 3 and 4 of the AES Huntington Beach Generating Station. The petition was heard at the California Energy Commission Business Meeting on October 20, 2010. The Order has been posted on the Energy Commission's website and was docketed on October 28, 2010. I have also enclosed a copy of the Notice of Decision filed with the Secretary of Resources and docketed at the Energy Commission on October 25, 2010.

This approved amendment extends the operation of Units 3 and 4 for an initial period of five years, until September 30, 2016 with the potential to extend to December 31, 2020 if an AFC is submitted by June 30, 2012 and determined to be data adequate by December 31, 2012.
