NOTICE OF RECEIPT
REQUEST FOR OWNERSHIP CHANGE OF
HUNTINGTON BEACH GENERATING STATION UNITS 3 & 4
(00-AFC-13C)

On March 30, 2011, Huntington Beach, LLC (AES) filed a petition with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting the transfer of ownership of Huntington Beach Generating Station Units 3 and 4 from AES to Edison Mission Huntington Beach, LLC (EMHB).

The HBGS is surrounded by industrial, commercial, residential, wetlands, and the Pacific Coast Highway and beaches in the City of Huntington Beach, Orange County, California. Units 3 & 4, with a total output of 450-megawatts, were certified by the Energy Commission on May 10, 2001 in an expedited process pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order D-22-01.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION

AES is petitioning the Energy Commission for a change of ownership approval for its Huntington Beach Generating Station Units 3 and 4. The request is to transfer ownership from AES to EMHB. There will be no operational changes to the project.

Pursuant to Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(b), EMHB will be responsible for compliance with the Commission's conditions of certification for the Huntington Beach Generating Station. As owner and operator of Units 3 and 4 of the Huntington Beach Generating Station, EMHB understands the conditions of certification and agrees to comply with them.

A public hearing for the purpose of approving or denying the petition to change ownership will subsequently be held at a regularly scheduled Energy Commission business meeting. This Notice of Receipt is being mailed to property owners adjacent to the project site and interested parties who may want to participate in the amendment process. If you wish to be removed from the Huntington Beach Generating Station project mailing list, please check the box on the enclosed form and return it to the address shown.
