ALMOND 2 POWER PLANT STATUS REPORT #4

This is the fourth monthly Status Report for the Almond 2 Power Plant ("A2PP") project filed by the Turlock Irrigation District (the "District"). The District submits this Status Report in compliance with the Committee Scheduling Order issued on August 10, 2009. This Status Report provides a summary of project licensing activities for the period November 1, 2009 through November 30, 2009.

On behalf of the District's ratepayer-owners, the District again wants to thank the Commissioners and the Staff for diligently pursuing this Application for Certification ("AFC"), especially in light of resource constraints and the tremendous workload facing the Commission. The A2PP project is the keystone in an integrated resource plan that will allow the District to achieve a twenty-eight percent (28%) Renewable Portfolio Standard ("RPS").

SATISFACTION OF CEC DATA REQUESTS RELATED TO THE NATURAL GAS **PIPELINE**

On September 2, 2009, the District filed a letter requesting additional time to respond to certain Data Requests related to the natural gas pipeline. PG&E had been evaluating the final routing for reinforcements to the PG&E system (Data Requests 18 and 77-79). PG&E has now selected an alignment that is the Preferred Alignment for natural gas service for the A2PP. The Preferred Alignment includes features that reinforce and improve PG&E's gas system. On November 24, 2009, the District submitted the analysis of the Preferred Alignment in satisfaction of Staff's requests.

SUCCESSFUL MEET AND CONFER WITH CURE

On October 14, 2009, California Unions for Reliable Energy ("CURE") filed Data Responses 1-106. The District filed objections to some of the Data Requests on November 3, 2009. As reported via email, the Applicant and CURE had a very productive meet and confer on Friday, November 13, 2009, reaching an accord on the issues of most concern to CURE. On Friday, November 20, 2009, the Applicant filed its responses to CURE's Data Requests. It is the Applicant's understanding that its responses satisfied CURE's informational requirements. The District thanks CURE for its professional approach and demeanor to resolving these informational issues and looks forward to continuing our productive working relationship.

SJVAPCD'S PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF COMPLIANCE ON TRACK

The District was recently informed by the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District ("SJVAPCD") that the Preliminary Determination of Compliance ("PDOC") is on track. It is the District's understanding that the PDOC has been completed and is currently undergoing management review. The District anticipates that the PDOC will be issued in early December.
